

# Birds of Cabrini Woods Nature Sanctuary

## **American Crow** *Corvus brachyrhynchos*

Year-round. 17-21". Black bills, legs, feet and feathers. Rounded tail.

## **American Redstart** *Setophaga ruticilla*

Spring, Fall. 4.3-5.1". M: black with orange side, wing and tail patches. F: gray with yellow patches.

## **American Robin** *Turdus migratorius*

Year-round. 9-11". Grayish brown back with warm orange breast. Females are paler.

## **Baltimore Oriole** *Icterus galbula*

Spring, Summer. 6.7-7.5". M: Orange with black head and wings. F: Yellow face, chest and belly. Both males and females have white wing bars.

## **Blue Jay** *Cyanocitta cristata*

Year-round. 10-12". White face and underside. Shades of blue, black and white on top.

## **Downy Woodpecker** *Picoides pubescens*

Year-round. 5-7". Black-and-white checkered. Males have red patch on back of their head.

## **Eastern Phoebe** *Sayornis phoebe*

Spring, Fall. 7". Brownish gray above; white underneath. Head usually has the darkest coloring.

## **Eastern Towhee** *Pipilo erythrophthalmus*

Spring, Fall. 6.8-8.2". M: Black head, throat, back and tail. White belly. F: Brown instead of black.

## **Golden-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus satrapa*

Spring, Fall. 3.1-4.3". Pale olive-gray body with black marks. Yellow crest; yellow-edged feathers.

## **Gray Catbird** *Dumetella carolinensis*

Spring, Summer, Fall. 8.3-9.4". Gray body with black cap and tail. Russet-colored under its tail.

## **House Sparrow** *Passer domesticus*

Year-round. 5.9-6.7". Brown wings and patches bordering the crown. Males have black bib.

## **Magnolia Warbler** *Setophaga magnolia*

Spring, Fall. 4.3-5.1". Gray crown, yellow chest and throat, black streaks. Less streaking on females.

## **Mourning Dove** *Zenaida macroura*

Year-round. 12". Small head with plump body. Buffy-tan with black spots on wings.

## **Northern Cardinal** *Cardinalis cardinalis*

Year-round. 8.3-9.1". Males are red with black around their bill. Females are mostly tawny.

## **Northern Flicker** *Colaptes auratus*

Spring, Summer, Fall. 13". Brown woodpecker with black spots and bars all-over. Red on back of neck.

## **Northern Mockingbird** *Mimus polyglottos*

Year-round. 8.3-10.2". Grayish brown with pale breast. White patches on wings/tails.

## **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** *Archilochus colubris*

Spring, Fall. 3-3.75". Green crown and back; gray belly. Males have iridescent red throat in the light.

## **Red-bellied Woodpecker** *Melanerpes carolinus*

Year-round. 9-10.5". Black-and-white striped back. Red crown with pale face and chest.

## **Red-tailed Hawk** *Buteo jamaicensis*

Year-round. 17-22". Brown back, white chest with brown streaks. Some: red band on tail.

## **Rock Pigeon** *Columba livia*

Year-round. 12.5". Most are bluish gray, but colors can vary. Iridescent neck feathers.

## **Ruby-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus calendula*

Spring, Fall. 3.5-4.3". Olive-gray body with white wing bars. Male's ruby crown is normally hidden.

## **Song Sparrow** *Melospiza melodia*

Spring, Summer, Fall. 4.7-6.7". Russet-and-gray colored with streaks down a white chest. Long tail.

## **White-breasted Nuthatch** *Sitta carolinensis*

Year-round. 5-6". Blue-gray back with black tail feathers. White throat and belly.

## **White-throated Sparrow** *Zonotrichia albicollis*

Year-round. 6.3-7.1". Brown above, gray below. Striped head and yellow spot near eyes.

## **Wood Thrush** *Hylocichla mustelina*

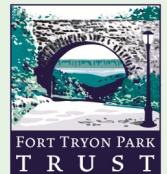
Spring, Fall. 7.5-8.3". Reddish brown head and back. White with black spots on neck and breast.

## **Yellow-rumped Warbler** *Setophaga coronata*

Spring, Fall. 4.7-5.5". Gray with yellow patches on face, sides and rump. Females may be brown.
